

## COVID-19 Protective Measures at Boyle Street Education Centre

- The school has secured ample access to, and purchased all necessary PPE supplies for staff, students and visitors for the 2020-21 school year. This includes:
  - Masks
  - Gloves
  - Hand sanitizer and hands-free sanitizing stations
- Closed microwave and coffee stations
- Secured two daily cleaning staff for additional cleaning needs throughout the school day
- Organized a deep clean of the school at the end of each school day
- Installed plexi-glass barriers between every space where physical distancing of 2 metres cannot be maintained
- Entry into the school is through one doorway and this doorway is monitored at all times
- All students and staff have signed a declaration which states that they are daily self-monitoring for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 and that they will not enter the building if they are exhibiting any of these symptoms
- Each person entering the building signs in and ensures they complete a daily health assessment
- Directional and one-way flow of foot traffic throughout the school building
- Instructional webinars are conducted virtually for all students and staff by school Admin regarding safe wearing of PPE and proper hand hygiene along with other health related guidelines during the pandemic. All staff, students and visitors wear masks in the school.
- Staff have been trained and have indicated understanding of all COVID protocols
- Washroom protocol has been established and is followed
- Daily cleaning of each learning space following instruction
- Each staff has conducted a COVID-19 hazard assessment of their work areas
